


Does liner shipping still need a special competition law regime?

- ☐ Conferences were exempted from Article 101 and still are in many parts of the world, like in the USA and in China
 - Conferences allowed the fixing of rates, i.e. prices, and conditions of carriage, incl. capacity
 - Abolished in the EU as of 18 October 2008
- ☐ Consortia are still exempted from Article 101
 - EU prolonged its Block Exemption Regulation until 2020
 - Market share threshold of 30%
- ☐ Consortia BER still needed or overtaken by events?
 - Global alliances down to three
 - Consolidation through mergers



Global Alliances Reshuffling






The Consortia BER 906/2009

- ☐ Entered into force 2010
- ☐ Expired 2015
- ☐ Prolonged in 2014 until 25 April 2020
- □ Review needed
- ☐ Possible outcomes are
 - Further prolongation
 - Amendment
 - Let it lapse
